



Revelation 8:12, "Then the fourth angel sounded: And a **third** of the sun was struck, a **third** of the moon, and a **third** of the stars, so that a **third** of them were darkened. A **third** of the day did not shine, and likewise the night."



he fourth of the seven trumpets brings about changes in the heavens. "A third of the sun was struck, a third of the moon, and a third of the stars, so that a third of them turned dark. A third of the day was without light, and also a third of the night".

Following the fourth trumpet judgment, John notes a special warning that comes from an eagle flying through the air. This eagle cries out with a loud voice, saying, "Woe! Woe! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth, because of the trumpet blasts about to be sounded by the other three angels" (Revelation 8:13). For this reason, the fifth, sixth, and seventh trumpets are referred to as the "three woes."
