


THE LAW

A Covenant between God and Man

[cov•e•nant] “A written agreement or promise usually under seal between two or more parties especially for the performance of some action”



Section II

Breaking of the Covenant

Gen. 2:17; Ez. 18:4, 20; I Cor. 15:56

2. Penalties – In the event this covenant is broken as outlined in Section 1 of the covenant, the penalty must be paid for by the blood of the party breaking said covenant.

2a. Exclusion: Penalty may be paid for by a substitute who must be found without sin. Substitute must be willing to assume all risk of the sinner.
