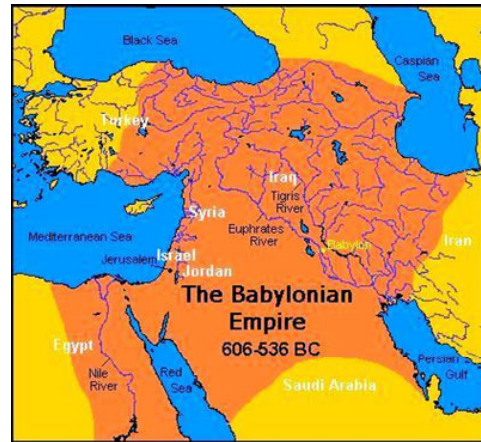


Lion with Eagles Wings

The fierceness of the Medo-Persian soldiers is depicted in the bear. When the Medes and Persians overthrew Babylon, they also conquered Lydia and Egypt. The three ribs in the bear's mouth represent these three nations—Babylon, Lydia, and Egypt..
